WE THE PEOPLE CONSTITUTION TOUR Challenge

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Who participates in the Challenge?

We are challenging **each school** that takes the **We the People Constitution Tour** to learn more about the U.S. Constitution and how it affects each of our lives today.

How does the Challenge work?

- Only classes that take the **We the People Constitution Tour** are permitted to participate.
- Both students and teachers can get involved in the *Challenge*.
- Students may work independently or together with other students.
- Students and teachers complete activities that help show their involvement with the Constitution.
- When a student/student team/teacher completes an activity they earn the points that are assigned to that specific activity. Each activity has a different number of points attached to it.
- Some of the *Challenge* activities are easy. Some of them are hard. And some are absolutely whacky!
- Students and teachers choose the activities they would like to complete.
- At the end of the *Challenge* period, the points that have been earned **by everyone participating from a school** are added up for a total. All points awarded will then be divided by the total number of students that attended the tour from that school. This ensures that smaller classes and schools are not at a disadvantage.
- Each class has **three (3) months** surrounding the **We the People Constitution Tour** to meet our *Challenge* and earn as many points as they can.

What are some of the Challenge activities?

- Complete your student and teacher evaluations of the tour—1 point/completed side
- Send us photos of you and your classmates on the tour—5 points/photo
- Complete your Student Guide from the **We the People Constitution Tour**—10 points
- Write about your experience on the tour in a blog posting—10 points/post (6-8 sentences)
- Return to one of the sites on your own and share your experience online—20 points
- Write a **We the People** essay (two pages, double-spaced)—25 points/essay
- Teacher attends a professional development class sponsored by a member of the **We the People Consortium**—100 points
